Learning Objective

This studio art course will familiarize students with the creative possibilities of mobile augmented reality (AR) and enable them to create simple but meaningful projects in AR.

Content

This course gives an overview of different types of augmented reality and how they might work in the future with wearables like Google Glass. Students will learn how to realize their own concepts in simple but meaningful AR projects. The only prerequisite is basic image processing skills – no programming is needed at all, but programmers are welcome! Advertising students might for instance do product enhancements, artists do visual art installations, graphic designers do augmented city walks, programmers do interactive data projects, etc. Group projects are encouraged!
